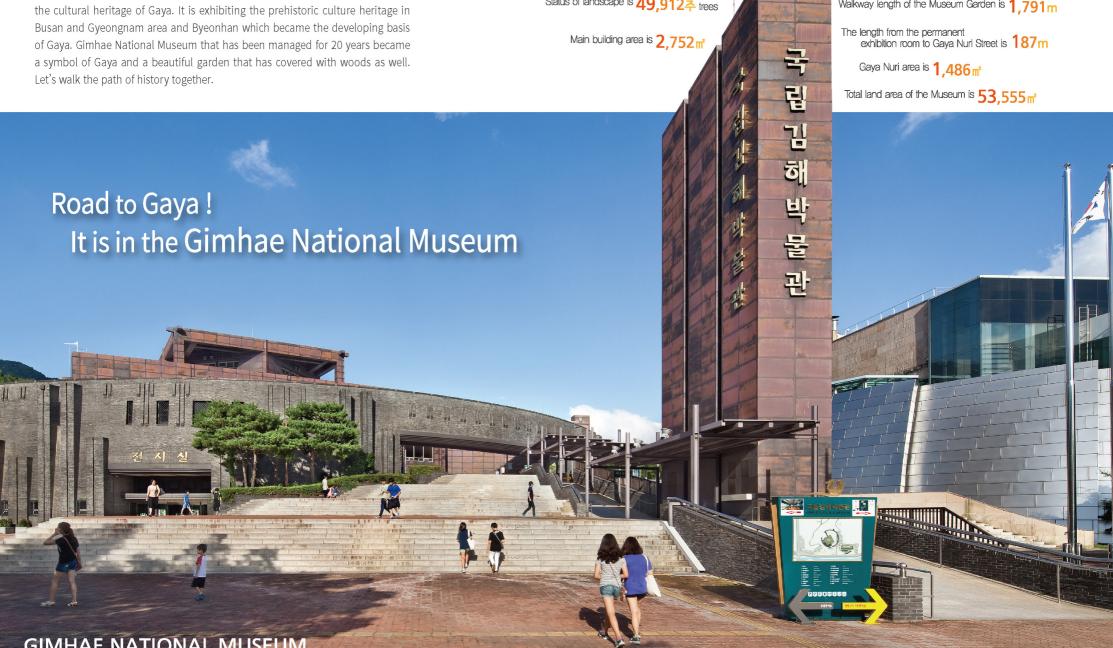

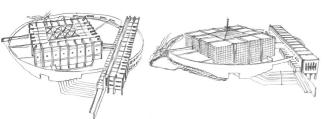

### The story of Main building, Gimhae National Museum

Gimhae National Museum is located on the foot of Gujibong, historical site. And it should be in harmony with the Museum building, not hurting the cultural symbol and historical sites. It, however, is hard to accord with surroundings when the Museum is built in the existing square frame. Museum is a space sharing the present and past. We thought the circle fence to display the time character. And we divided the space by putting the square into the circle fence. We made a harmony with Gujibong as an outer part which is remained after facing the circle and square. It is made to meet the city Gimhae through the whole main gate and be melted the Museum into the Gujibong Park. Through this, the Museum was built to meet the present and past times along with Gimhae and Gujibong. And the exhibition building which is popped up with square shape in the circle fence is made to symbolize the shape of piling the flowing time and Iron culture by making the color of iron plate change with the passage of time.

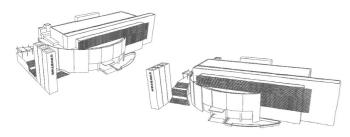

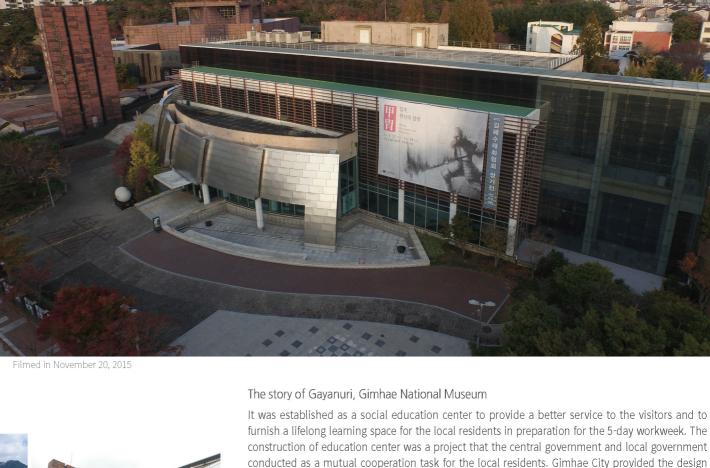

Since the construction of the social education center had to be harmonized as one with the main building which had already been completed, we tried to reduce the sense of heterogeneity with the main building of Museum by using simple and geometric proportions. Like the main building, the Gayanuri used the circle and square and was designed as a same background element. The name of "Gayanuri" was decided in 2006 through a name contest for the social education center. "Gayanuri" is a building located in the area of old Gaya, and it has a meaning to be a good place to

spread the spirit and life of the ancestors.

- 5. The hidden forsythia flower path of the Museum. Quince flowers are waiting for you on the left. (Taken on Mar 28, 2017)

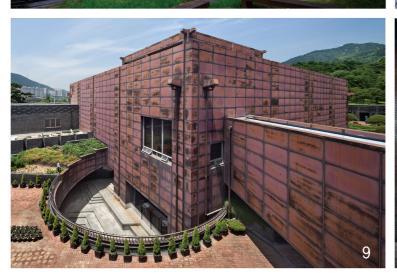

- 9. The weather-resistant steel sheet used in the Museum is a special material developed by POSCO. It becomes dark brown as it is oxidized and the rust made from oxidation becomes a protective coating to protect the inner steel sheet permanently. (Taken on July 25, 2015)

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## Historical sites beside the Museum

### Gujibong

Designated item Historical site I Age Gaya Designated No Historical site No. 429



It is said that the founder of Gaya King Suro was born. The Gujibong has a large round shape of peak as if a turtle is lying on its face. It is also the place that became the material of song of "Guji" which occupies an important position in the history of Korean literature.

龜何龜何 guhaguha 首其現也 sugihyeon-ya Turtle, turtle, stick you head out 若不現也 yagbulhyeon-ya 燔灼而喫也 beonjagi-kkik-ya If not, I will bake and eat.



There is a dolmen of the 4th century BC in the top. The dolmen is covered with a cover stone of about 2.5m in diameter on about 5-6 short support stones. There is a word "Gujibong stone" engraved on the stone. It is an important relic where the founding myth of Gaya dwells in it.

### Queen's Tomb of King Suro

Designated item Historical site I Age: Gaya Designated No: Historical site No. 74 Queen's Grave of King Suro



This Tomb is about 16m in diameter and about 5m high. It is known that the queen's surname was Huh, her name Hwang-ok. It is said that she was originally a princess of the Ayodhya in India, and she came to Gaya in 48 years to become the wife of King Suro. There is a stone table in the center and a tombstone is set up on which a word "Tomb of Queen Huh, the wife of King Suro, Gaya - 駕洛國首露王妃普州太后許氏陵" is engraved. The remaining gravestone and stone offertory table in front of the tomb were installed in 1647 (King Injo 25 years) while reestablishing the grave.

# Pasa stone pagoda

Cultural properties data No. 227, Gyeongsangnam-do

It is said that it was carried out when Queen of King Suro came across the sea from Ayodhya, the country to the west of China, to Gaya. In the book of Memorabilia of the Three Kingdoms (Samgukyusa), it is recorded that it was loaded on the ship to make the storm calm.
